## Criteria for the Annual Kansas Board of Regents Faculty of the Year Award

## **Nominees**

Eligibility is restricted to faculty meeting the following requirements:

- Full-time, <u>classified as tenured</u>, <u>or non-tenure-track</u> faculty
- Demonstrate one's <u>excellence</u> in their <u>university duties</u> (<u>including</u> teaching, scholarship/research, <u>extension</u>, <u>libraries</u>, <u>clinical duties</u>, <u>and</u> service <u>and other roles</u>) <u>over the preceding academic year\* have exemplified excellence</u> and commitment to the mission of the institution <u>over the preceding academic year\*</u>. (<u>confirmed by the dean of their respective college</u>)
- Have not received the annual KBOR Faculty of the Year Award in the previous two (2) years.

## **Nominations**

Nominations must adhere to the following guidelines to be accepted:

- Nominations may only be submitted by a faculty senator employed at the same institution as the nominee during the preceding academic year. \*
